What are Cookies and How are Cookies used on this Site

This Site may request Cookies to be set on your device. A Cookie is a small text file that is stored on a user's computer for record-keeping purposes. We do not link the information we store in Cookies to personally identifiable information you submit while on this Site.

When we say "**Cookies**" we are also referring to similar technologies for installing on and/or collecting information from your device such as web beacons, pixel tags, HTML Cookies. Sometimes your data is stored in the "local storage" of your browser. Third parties with whom we partner to provide certain features on the Site also use your local storage to store and collect information.

Cookies are necessary to facilitate navigation and to know how users interact with the Site so that we can improve it. The main objective of our Cookies is to make your browsing experience more convenient and efficient. We also use Cookies to let us know when you visit this Site and how you interact with us (e.g. where you click, the time of your visit, etc.). You can change your Cookie preferences by selecting to turn certain Cookies off. Please note that blocking some types of Cookies may impact your experience on this Site and the services we are able to offer.

Sometimes the use of Cookies entails the processing of personal data. Please see our Privacy Policy if you want to obtain more information about how we process such personal data and how to exercise your data protection rights.

Who uses the information stored in Cookies?

The information stored in our Site's Cookies is used exclusively by us (or by third parties acting on our behalf), with the exception of those identified below as "Third Party Cookies", which are used and managed by external entities to provide services requested by us.

Which are the types of Cookies?

This section provides an overview of the types of Cookies that can be used in an online environment.

Depending on the owner of the Cookie, they can be classified as:

- **First-party Cookies:** These are sent to the user's computer or device from a computer or domain managed by the publisher itself, and from which the website requested by the user is provided.

- **Third-party Cookies:** These are those that are sent to the user's computer or device from a computer or domain that is not managed by the publisher, but by another entity that processes the data obtained through Cookies.

Depending on the purpose of the Cookie, they can be classified as:

- **Essential Cookies:** These Cookies enable the user to navigate through a website, platform or application and use the different options or services available on them, such as controlling traffic, identifying data or the session, accessing sections or content with restricted access, remembering the elements that make up an order, carrying out the purchase process for an order, using security elements during navigation, storing content for the dissemination of videos or sound, or sharing content through social networks. These cookies do not store any personally identifiable data.
- **Analytics Cookies:** These Cookies allow us to quantify the number of users, the sections visited on the Site and how they interact with it, in order to measure and statistically analyze the use made by users.
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Depending on the expiration time of the Cookie:

- **Session Cookies:** They expire when you close your browser.
- **Persistent Cookies:** They remain on your hard drive for an extended period of time.
